The French Ice Skating Federation (FFSG) and the Club CGALE have the honor and pleasure to invite you to the competition Starclass.

This Starclass in GRENOBLE will be held on november 28th to 30th 2014 at ice rink Patinoire d'agglomération Polesud, Avenue d'Innsbruck 38100 Grenoble (FRA)

In accordance with the 2014 Regulations of the International Skating Union, the Starclass Memorandum 2014/2015 and the conditions included in this announcement.

*for the category Starclass juniors C the A and B finals shall be over 1500m, all other finals/qualifying rounds can be skated over 1000m

** for the category Starclass Novices the A and B finals shall be over 1000m all others can be skated over 777m

Age before July the 1st preceding the Competition

Relays races may be added to the program and must have a demonstrational character. No awards may be given for these Races. Teams may be mixed, boys and girls, and formed with all categories but from same Team.

Competition site

The competition will be carried out in Pole Sud -Grenoble FRANCE. The track is an artificial refrigerated indoor ice surface measuring 30x60 m.

The compass of the track is 111.12 m, according to ISU Rules. During the competition there will be used 5 tracks separated of 1m each. The finish line for all distances is the same ; only the starting lines for distances 500 and 1500 m will change ; for 777m, 1000 m and the relays it will not be changed.

Equipments

Only equipments, which are in accordance with the ISU rules can be used in the competition. The compulsory rounding of the tips of blades will be controlled.

Entries

Entries can be made by the Club of the respective athletes or by the Member of the International Skating Union. In case of an unmanageable number of entries, reductions can be made by organizers together with the Coordination Group.

In this respect the total number of skaters in all categories by club may be limited and/or the number of Clubs may be limited. Principles like global representation, regional representation and first come, first served shall be applied.

Entry Fee

An entry fee of **€ 10,00** - per skater has to be paid in cash at the check-in.

All entries must be accompanied of sufficient documentation of performance in Mass start competitions and all requirements of ISU Regulations must be fulfilled (Insurance, minimum

age to compete in a senior competition etc.). Please precise if National Team.

All team leaders are very urgently requested to inform the organizers immediately of any changes upon departure from their town, on Thursday, at the very latest.

The entrance fee of € 10 must be paid to organizers for each accredited person, i.g. for every athlete and for every coach/team leader. However one coach/team leader per club is able to attend free of entry fees.

Deposit for helmet covers € 10.00 per athlete.

Conditions of contest

The qualifying schedule on each distance shall be based on an "All Final System" in all categories. The all Final system is used in order to guarantee a minimum of races to all participants.

The organizers reserve the right to change program due to unforeseen circumstances.

Award of prizes

Prizes for first, second and third classed in final results in each category-ladies and men..

During award ceremonies, the skaters should be in club or national team suits.

Each distance awards be given to the first three competitors in the final.

Medical assistance:

A medical doctor and paramedical personnel will be present on the competition days. An ambulance will be on standby in case of need

Medical insurance

It is the sole responsibility of each member, on behalf of its participating club, to ensure or provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes. Proof of such shall be requested by organizing committee (see ISU rule 119)

Liability

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, the organizing committee assumes no responsibility with respect to medical, bodily or personal injury or property loss or damage sustained or caused in connection with this Competition.

Meals

The ice rink restaurant "La gueule du Loup" proposes good and well balanced meals for 10 euros per person. It includes a starter, a hot dish with meat and potatoes, or rice or pasta and a dessert. The ice rink restaurant is open from 11 am to 3 pm. We propose meals Friday, Saturday and Sunday (lunch only).
